



Questions for the Professional Testing Your Child

Questions to Ask Yourself Prior to Testing

1. What areas do I see my child may have issues?
2. What information should I provide the professional?

Questions for the Professional

- What credentials/training have you had in educational testing?
- What experience have you had with testing students my child's age?
- How long have you been doing assessments?
- What information do you expect me to provide? Will you contact my child's school for information?
- Will the assessment include any of the tests generally given in the public schools?
- How should I prepare my child for the assessment process?
- Can I expect a written report at the end of the assessment?
- Will the final report integrate all of the individual tests done?
- How much will the assessment cost?
- How soon can I expect the assessment results?

Review Questions After the Appointment

- Were the assessment report results clear? If not, was the professional able to answer all of my questions? If not, get clarification.
- What did the professional recommend for my child based on these test results? What action should I now take?
